## Make Your Own Halloween Bunting



Fold line

You will need  
scissors • string  
• sticky tape  
or glue

### Instructions

1. Print and cut out this sheet as many times as you need to make the length of bunting you want.

2. Fold along the dotted line.


3. Lay out the bunting face down and place the string along into the fold line leaving plenty of string either end for tying up.

4. Glue or tape the fold down, making sure the string sits at the top of the fold.

That's it! Hang up your bunting!

### Optional for windows

For double sided bunting, instead of folding along the line, cut across it. Glue that piece to the back of another piece after the string has been glued in place.




For adults  
Some children may need help with cutting and gluing.

Tip  
By keeping the glue or tape away from the string, you will be able to reposition the bunting along the string once it's up.

Tip  
The extra colour around the edge means that it won't matter if you are a bit wobbly with the scissors!



You will need  
a die • a cookie for  
each player • coloured  
writing icing tubes



### Instructions for younger players

1. Give each player a cookie and place the tubes of writing icing in the middle where everyone can reach them.
2. The youngest player rolls the die first.
3. Following the number guide, shown left, the player then draws the corresponding feature on their biscuit.
4. Play continues to the left until each player finishes their Mischief Monster face.


That's it! The Mischief Monster Cookies are ready to eat!

### Instructions for older players


As above but each player has to roll a six to start.

For extra fun, use cake decorating sprinkles so that the winner can add them to their cookie!






## Make Your Own Spider Web

You will need  
thin paper - ideally in black,  
orange, green or purple •  
ruler • scissors • pencil

### Instructions

1. Take a piece of paper and using the ruler and pencil, measure, mark and cut out a square.
2. Fold into a triangle and fold again to make a smaller triangle.
3. With the large point facing you, fold in the outer edges to meet in the middle.
4. Turn it over and with the scissors, cut 2 curves as shown.
5. Draw some lines almost all of the way into the centre on both sides, starting at the top and working towards the point. There should be an even number of lines. Join up the short edges to make rectangles.
6. Cut out the rectangle shapes on both edges.

That's it! Open the folds and hang up.  
Repeat as many times as you like with  
different coloured paper to make your  
Halloween display!



## Make your own Spooky Ghost Train!

Sheet No 1

**You will need**  
small cardboard food boxes • tubes with lids are ideal • scissors • plastic bottle top lids - 2 large, and at least 9 small • pencil • sticky tape • strong glue or glue dots • paper or thin card • string or wool • red, blue, brown and black paint • brushes • water pots



### Instructions



1. Attach the tube to the box using the tape. This will be the engine of the train.
2. Cut the string or wool about 10cm long and tape to the back of the box. Take another box and fix the other end of the string to it. This is the train carriage.
3. Next cut out two strips of paper or thin card that are the same width as the two boxes, long enough to create an arch over them.
4. Attach the paper to the boxes with plenty of tape as shown.
5. Take some paper or thin card and cut out a rectangle roughly 10cm x 5cm. Roll into a cylinder and secure with tape. Make small cuts into one end and splay out. This is the funnel.
6. Attach the funnel to the front of the engine.
7. Paint the engine red, the carriage blue and the funnel brown.
8. Once dry, take the large plastic bottle lids and using a strong glue or glue dots, place them on the sides of the engine to create the wheels. Place one on the top of the funnel also.
9. Paint the wheels brown (optional) and allow to dry. Cut out some window shapes, paint and stick in place with glue.

That's it! The Spooky Ghost Train is ready to play with! For extra fun, cut out Pip and Posy's ghost friends and stick to the train.



### Tip

Raid the recycling to find a variety of shapes. Your train can be larger and any shape you like!


**Tip**




**Tip**  
A loo roll centre can be cut along the length and rolled tighter to make the funnel. Secure with tape.




